Since completing my teacher training I've used the Dalcroze method, which is an active-inquiry approach using the whole body as the main instrument. I am and have been responsible for the Christmas festivals, Mother's Day, and other international and community festivities in all these schools. The lessons are taught in a specially designed classroom with improvised music from a piano to fully engage and tune in the students' ears and imagination. In most of these schools, choirs were formed to further the children's musical experience.

My primary objective while collaborating with these institutions was to introduce an engaging methodology for Solfege instruction utilizing the Dalcroze method. In this capacity, I oversaw multiple groups, catering to ages 7 to 15. Notably, I contributed as an advisor in formulating the Solfege curriculum for elementary-level students for the *Superior School of Music* which is still used to this day. This multifaceted role also encompassed conducting routine discussions with parents to address their children's progress and participating in the evaluation process for prospective students. All of these educational institutions are located in Mexico City.

I've worked as a mentor with teacher seeking certifications in different programs including: PGCE in UK, Instructor within the first Dalcroze Certificate program in Latin America. Over the course of this engagement, I guided three cohorts of music educators seeking to expand their expertise. As an independent lecturer I lead workshops and

seminars across prominent cities in Mexico, as well as USA, Canada and Vietnam. My instructional reach encompasses individuals from diverse backgrounds, ranging from novices to highly trained professionals musicians and non-musicians alike. Additionally, I conducted a series of workshops tailored to educators in regions in the center of México who work in schools without specialist music teachers. Notably, this initiative encompassed groups of up to 150 participants throughout the 2016-2017 school year. Furthermore, I have conducted an online workshop for music teachers in Spanish, with attendants from the Americas, Asia and Europe.
